



## Innovation Challenge 12 FAQ

**Q: Are there restrictions on how the prize money can be spent?**

A: The prize money can be used by the I'Challenge winners in any way they choose. However, each innovation team should be prepared to discuss their plans for using prize money, during the judging.

Some teams may elect to devote all of the funds to continuation of their project; others may choose to apply the funds to more personal uses (e.g. tuition payments); still others may have uses not foreseen by the organizing committee. Entrants may want to confer with faculty advisors about local departmental or collegiate constraints. Above all, be innovative!

**Q: Can we add members to the team?**

A: Yes, but you must notify the organizing committee of the identity and particulars of new people. We want to prepare for the correct number of competitors and to maintain good documentation.

**Q: Can we use any presentation aids for the competition, such as PowerPoint, video or multiple posters?**

A: The oral presentation is expected to be illustrated. The format will be pptx, and the presentations will be loaded onto a centralized computer prior to the competition. All special effects (e.g., web connections, videos, etc.) must be contained within the pptx file and must be formatted for instant access. Practice is advised. Also, keep in mind that you have a ten-minute time limit.

The poster competition is limited to one [1] poster, at a maximum size of 36" x 48", oriented either in landscape or portrait.

**Q: Will a computer, projector and screen be available?**

A: Yes. All presentations must be delivered to the competition committee prior to the competition in pptx format. You will be notified of the deadline. All files will be pre-loaded, in the order of the presentations. At the competition, the slide file will be opened by a projectionist during the introduction of the presenter.
